



Butterfly Art Competition Rules

- The competition is open to any primary school pupils in P4, P5, P6 and P7, or Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6.
- Only one entry per pupil.
- The picture entered must be of a butterfly, but any art materials can be used to create the picture, including felt-tip pens, pencils, paints, crayons, or even fabric, sequins, glitter, wool or collage – use your imagination!
- The entrant's name, school address and primary class/year must be written clearly on the back of each picture.
- Three first place winners will receive a butterfly growing kit, the next three will receive a butterfly kite. Ten runners-up will receive butterfly nature books, and the next ten will receive small butterfly hand kites. Twenty commended entrants will receive butterfly stickers.
- Winners, runners-up and commended entrants will all receive a signed certificate.
- All pictures entered into the competition will be displayed at the book launch for *The Boy with the Butterfly Mind* in September, and will be displayed on my website: www.strangelymagical.com/competitions
